At the first practice on June 4th, debt-free seniors will receive their cap/gown/tassel, along with four (4) "Auditorium" tickets for seating in the Calvary Church Auditorium and two (2) "Fellowship Hall/Chapel" tickets for seating in the Fellowship Hall or Chapel live video-feed rooms.

EXTRA TICKETS

Students needing extra tickets can check with classmates who may have extras. Due to the size of our graduating class and the fire code capacity at Calvary Church, we will not be able to offer any extra tickets. We appreciate your understanding. Please note that in addition to in-person seating, the ceremony will be live-streamed on the internet. This will offer an opportunity for those unable to attend in person to still participate in the celebration

GRADUATION REHEARSALS

Attendance at all graduation rehearsals is MANDATORY. Please note that transportation is <u>not</u> provided. Report directly to the Calvary Church, 1051 Landis Valley Road, Lancaster, on June 4th @ 7:45 am and on June 5th @ 9:30 am (please allow yourself travel time on 6/4 - traffic will be very heavy at that time of the morning). Please do not arrive late as it will prolong practices for you and your peers. Practices will last approximately 3 hours.

STUDENT OBLIGATIONS

Seniors are responsible to return school property/pay all debts prior to graduation. You may view the status of your debts on your Sapphire Community Portal account or inquire in the main office at the high school – please don't wait until the last minute to check for

COMMENCEMENT ATTIRE

Ladies

- Dresses or dress pants (no jeans) dress hemlines must be higher than your commencement gown hemline
- Dress shoes (no sneakers, flip flops or work boots) remember you will be walking up/down stairs
- Do not wear excessive jewelry, flowers or corsages

Gentlemen

- Dress pants (no jeans)
- White dress shirt and tie (we have ties you may borrow if needed)
- Dress shoes (no sneakers, flip flops or work boots)

All Students

Discard the white collar that comes with your cap/gown unit

- Tassel is worn over the right front quarter of your cap - make sure it is fastened securely to your cap
- Do not place artwork, decoration or writing on your cap or gown - we will have extras at the church, and you will need to change if you decorate your cap or gown
- If you wish to wear cords, medals, or pins that were not provided by the school, you must first check with Mr. Ridley in the main office for approval. Only military or school-sponsored or awarded items are allowed. Unauthorized items might be confiscated the night of the ceremony.
- No accessories or toys
- No sunglasses, cell phones, gum or candy
- All attire must be school appropriate
- IMPORTANT NOTE: Seniors who do not present themselves properly dressed <u>may not participate in</u> <u>commencement.</u> Any seniors needing assistance with dress code, please see Mrs. Ridley in the main office

CAP TOSS

A Class of 2025 Cap Toss will be organized to ensure everyone has the opportunity to capture the moment on film or video. The Senior Class



President will lead the class in the moving of the tassel and cap toss. If you plan to keep your tassel, please remove it before tossing your cap. Each cap has a designated area to write your name inside. If you cannot find your cap after the toss, please check with the main office. Any caps found will be held for pickup until the end of June.

POST-COMMENCEMENT INSTRUCTIONS

At the conclusion of the graduation ceremony, the audience is asked to remain seated while the class processes out the front of the auditorium. We ask that families have a prearranged meeting place, preferably the church parking lot, to avoid congestion in the church lobby once every student has processed out.
