If you are taking an Advanced Placement (AP) exam in May, please read the [2025 MTHS AP Exam Reminders](#) carefully for important information to know before your test day. You can find this informational letter in The Week Ahead or on Schoology. It includes the exam schedule, report times, devices needed, and other details that you would want to review.

All Seniors must fill out the Mandatory Senior Survey which informs the district on their post-secondary plans and must be reported to the state. **It is also how the Counseling Office knows where to send final transcripts.** The Senior Survey can be accessed on the Class of 2025 page on Schoology. **The deadline to submit your Senior Survey is Friday, May 16th.** Any questions or changes to what is submitted can be directed to Mrs. Lawrence in the Counseling Office.

**Locker Clean Out:** Seniors must clean their lockers by Tuesday, May 27, and underclassmen by Thursday, June 5. Leave the door open with the padlock locked on the hasp. **If the lock is still facing backwards and the student DID NOT use their locker – they do not need to open the locker. There will be a \$6.50 fee for missing locks.** This will be added to the student debt list. Seniors will need to pay all debts prior to graduation.
