## **Drop Off**

- **Students should be picked up in the car rider loop**
- **Students cannot access your car beyond a certain point in the loop for safety purposes**

# ACADEMIC

- **High Expectations for all students!**
- **Instructional experiences/strategies that promote:**
  - **Development of well-rounded learners**
  - **Differentiated learning styles**
  - **Individualized skills and needs**
  - **Inquiry based learning**



- Students must be in homeroom by 8:10 am or they are counted as tardy- If they arrive after 8:10 they must sign in at the office
  - Tardy minutes will add up to full day unlawful absences
- Parents/Guardians have 3 days to turn in a note for a student(s) absence
  - Anything after 3 days will not be accepted and be an unlawful absence
- A School Attendance Improvement Conference (SAIC) will occur after the 6<sup>th</sup> unlawful absence
- After the 10<sup>th</sup> missed school day a doctors note will be required or they will be counted as unlawful absences



# ATTENDANCE CONTINUED
