

This is a reminder to all students that all vehicles must be registered and must display a school issued parking permit to park on school property during school hours. Parking permits are available from Mrs. Faller in the main office before school, after school, during study hall, and lunch. There will be no warnings issued for students parked on school property without a valid parking permit and all unregistered vehicles will receive a parking violation. **Students with parking permits are reminded that they may only park in their assigned lot.** Please make sure your parking permit is displayed.

The Activity Bus for the 2025-2026 school year is by reservation only and there are limited seats available. Students must be signed up to stay with a teacher or a specific activity to ride the Activity Bus. The Activity Bus Form can be found on each grade's "Class of" pages in Schoology. One activity bus will run on Tuesday, and one bus will run on Thursday. The bus typically leaves the high school at or about 4:15pm. No unscheduled students will be permitted to ride the activity bus.
