Event Expectations

School events are an exciting time for our community to come together and to support our teams, musicians, and other student groups. Maintaining safety and supervision at our events is a priority; in partnership with families, it allows all of our fans and guests access to these events.

The Lancaster-Lebanon League's educational initiatives are applicable, but not limited to, interscholastic athletic scrimmages, events, and participation in championship tournaments. Per the PIAA Athletic Courtesy section of the PIAA By-Laws, the Lancaster-Lebanon League expects:

- Respectful communication and cooperation between all individuals.
- Proper treatment of officials by all individuals.
- Courtesy shown to opponents.
- Proper behavior exhibited by spectators.
- Every person treats others with dignity and respect at all times.
- School and team programming that promotes inclusion and respect.

Manheim Township School District home events and contests have the following expectations:

- Elementary, Landis Run Intermediate School (LRIS), and Middle School students must be accompanied and supervised by an adult (21+) at all times. Unaccompanied students will not be admitted.
- High school students from Manheim Township or the visiting school who are unaccompanied must present a valid student ID (physical card or digital ID) to purchase a ticket and enter the game.
- Students from non-participating schools will not be admitted unless accompanied by an adult (21+).
- Manheim Township School District reserves the right to request identification from any guest and may deny entry or remove individuals at its discretion.
- Tickets are not guaranteed to be sold for the duration of each athletic event. Football tickets will not be sold after the third quarter. Other sports will follow a similar timeline.
- Students must be picked up within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the game.

Prohibited Items

- Bags, including backpacks, along with skateboards, scooters, footballs, flags, blow horns, bubbles, and other disruptive items are not permitted. All bags are subject to search.
- No alcohol, vapes, nicotine, or illegal substances (to include medical marijuana)
- Food, drink (except water), and gum are not permitted on turf areas.

Expectations for All Spectators

- Cheer for your team. Do not cheer against the opposing team.
- Represent yourself and your school with pride.
- Maintain appropriate messaging, chants, and language.
- Do not call out to the refs, opposing players/coaches, opposing student sections.
- If choosing to wear face paint, ensure it is below the eye.
- Face coverings are prohibited unless there is a religious exemption

Enforcement

Manheim Township School District reserves the right to remove any guest who fails to meet these expectations. Students or guests who violate the District's Code of Conduct may also be restricted from attending future events.
