Physical Requirement

Physical Form

Two Twelve (12) player Teams (Boys and Girls) will be selected to the MTHS Golf Teams
54 Hole Aggregate Score Tryout -Top 12 scores will make the team**

Tuesday, August 11 (18 Holes) - Tee Times begin at 12:20 PM

First Cut:

Boys-determined by Coaching Staff after the first 36 holes

Girls-Low 16 and anyone who has had 260 or less

Wednesday, August 12 (18 Holes, if necessary) - Tee Times begin at 12:20 PM

Thursday, August 13 - 1st Team Practice; **Team Kick Off Meeting including parents following**

Friday, August 14 - 2nd Team Practice

Monday, August 17 - Boys Section 1 Match at ETOWN

Tees - Boys Blue (Back); Girls 85% of Boys (Combination)

*The Tryout/Team Committee (Todd Scolnick, Maci Seibel, Dave Rilatt, and Tim Hollenbeck) reserve the right to make any changes deemed necessary to Tryouts (ie. Illness, weather, other extenuating circumstances...)

*Boys Team: Players need to demonstrate an ability to play within 4 hours for 18 holes and shoot below 60 for 9 holes

*Girl's Team: Players need to demonstrate an ability to play within 4 hours for 18 holes, and shoot below 65 for 9 holes

**The Committee has the right to modify the last two players to make the Team (those who finish 11 and 12) in order to benefit the program

Qualifying for Matches

Exemptions*:

- Players who shoot 79 or better in previous match
- Players who shoot top 2 in the previous match (girls team)
- Players who finish in the top 10 in previous match

Qualifying - for players who are not exempt, a 9 or 18 hole qualifying (pending on time) will be had to fill remaining spots.

**Subject to coaches decisions*

Expected Behavior

1. Respect Staff (Coaches, teachers, administrators, etc..)
2. Respect Teammates and Classmates
3. Respect Yourself - Act in a mature fashion both on and off the course.
4. Respect Community - We are guests of the golf courses where we practice, play and compete.
5. No cell phone use during play.

Any player found not in compliance with these expectations risks possible disciplinary action from the team.

6. All players will sign a [Code of Conduct](#) in agreement with Overlook Expectations (Zero Tolerance Policy)

Academics

Academics come first. All players are required to meet the standards set by the school district. If players are having a problem in any of their classes, please come see me BEFORE it becomes a problem and I can help.

Spectators

There are no spectators allowed for tryouts AND practices. Spectators for matches are permitted to walk along the course to watch players. Spectators must remain on the cart paths or in the rough and at least 30 yards away from the players. Please do not walk on the fairways. Do not give advice to a player during their round. Giving "advice" or coaching by a spectator is not permitted by the USGA Rules of Golf. The golfer/competitor may be penalized. Spectators may help look for lost balls and be a spotter.

Attendance

Practice - All players are expected to attend practices at Overlook Golf Course as scheduled.

- If players are going to miss scheduled practices/matches, the coach must be notified before. If missed practices are deemed to be "unexcused" the coaching staff will discuss possible consequences with the player.

Players are expected to get their own transportation to practices.

Matches - Only players who qualify for Matches will attend matches. Transportation to matches will be provided by the District

Dress

All players will wear a collared shirt tucked in and golf-type shorts or slacks (or skirts for girls). No Denim.

Boys: Players participating in matches will wear the school provided team shirt and khaki pants/shorts.

Girls: Players participating in matches will wear the school provided team shirt and skirts.

If the weather is cold, players will wear black, navy, white, or khaki pants, and appropriate cold weather/ rain gear.

Equipment Needed

All players are required to have all necessary equipment to play including, clubs, balls, tees, gloves, shoes, etc... If a player is in need, please see Coach Scolnick or Coach Seibel for assistance.
