## **Educational Video Library (EVL)**

Our filtering software offers a feature that allows teachers to approve YouTube videos for students to view. Teachers have the capability to make any YouTube video accessible to every student in the district. Please keep in mind that any video that is approved can be viewed by elementary students.

1. While viewing a YouTube video, copy the URL from your browser's address bar. (Note: You will need to login to the filter to visit YouTube.)




2. Go to <a href="http://videos.mtwp.net">http://videos.mtwp.net</a>, and click on the *Login* link in the upper right corner. Login using your network username/password.

3. Click the *Submit a Video* link. Paste the YouTube URL you copied in step 1, then click the *Get Video* button.




4. Enter a movie title (the title used on YouTube is prefilled), select an educational category, enter tags that might make it easier for students to search for your video, enter any notes about the video, and enter your email address (mandatory). Do not select the "Notify me when video is approved" checkbox – you will do the approval in the next step! Click the Submit Video button.



5. Click the Review Videos link in the upper right corner.

You should see the video you just submitted. Click the *Allow* link to make it available to everyone in the district.



After allowing the video, you can click on the *Approved Videos* tab to confirm that your video is now available to everyone.
