

When a student participating in co-curricular activities fails to meet the weekly academic standard, the failure will be reported as outlined in the Student Handbook. Any student athlete reported as failing two or more subjects, no matter what courses are involved, is ineligible for a one-week period. The consequences for weekly ineligibility are outlined below:

### **Eligibility Guidelines**

1st Week - Student may practice, but cannot play in a scheduled contest. (This means the student can attend the club meeting but may not participate in them nor in any club activities).

2nd & 3<sup>rd</sup> Week - Student may not practice or play in a scheduled contest; the ineligible student is not permitted to attend practice even as an observer. (The student may not attend club meetings EXCEPT for those held during club period, which he/she should attend, but may NOT participate in any way.)

4th Week - The academically ineligible student is removed from the team. (The student must be removed from the club. If it is a club that meets during club period, the student is to be assigned to a club study hall.)
