

TODAY IS A CLUB DAY.

The list of student club assignments is posted on the ramp wall by the cafeteria. Students can also view their club assignment/schedule online via the Sapphire Community Portal. Students **MUST** report to the club that they are assigned to for the first club day.

There were several clubs that did not have enough room to accommodate the number of students who requested them (basketball, volleyball, etc.). Students whose first and second choice were not available were placed into a club study hall. There are clubs with openings and club study hall students may select a club to join from that list.
