

Attention Student Drivers: This is a reminder that all student drivers are required to have a valid 2018/19 parking permit to be able to park on campus during school hours. You must park in the parking lot you selected when you purchased your parking permit. Lots B, D and E are mixed lots for both students and staff. **Staff spaces will be marked with a yellow dot.** Lot F is for staff use only. Do not park in staff spaces, visitor spaces, along the curb, in front of fire hydrants, or in the handicap spaces. Failure to follow these rules will result in violations as listed in the student parking agreement. Please note that daily parking passes are not available at this time.

The PSAT will be offered at MTHS on Saturday, October 13th for interested students in grades 9-11. The cost of the test will be \$25. Any student interested in signing up can bring their payment to the Counseling Office. A limited number of tests are available so please sign up early.
