

**STUDENT PARKING:** The Band Parking Lot between the Middle School and High School is closed for construction. The closing of this lot necessitates the shifting of middle school staff, high school staff, and students. The following changes are effective immediately. [All changes are reflected on the campus map provided.](#) *If you have any questions about your parking location see Mrs. Faller in the main lobby.*

- Students who have been parking in the Band Lot with parking permit numbers #1-130 should be parking in the Baseball Lot.
- Students with parking permit numbers #201-270 may remain in the Arena Lot.
- Students with parking permit numbers #271-300 should be parking in the Mixed-Use Lot (Staff and Students) in the front of the building near the baseball field.
- Students parking in the Small Arena Lot will continue to park there.
- Students with permit numbers not identified above, will be reassigned/returned to other parking lots as availability allows. These students are being notified directly of this change.

*It is extremely important that students park in their assigned lots. There will be no warnings issued for students parking in an unassigned lot or parking without a valid permit. Thank you for your flexibility through the construction process.*

**Seniors - Important information about Senior Privilege (late arrival and early release) for second semester: YOU MUST REAPPLY FOR SENIOR PRIVILEGE FOR SECOND SEMESTER.** Even if your schedule does not change from first semester, you **MUST** submit a new application. NOTE: You do not need to reapply for club early release since that is a year-long privilege. Applications will be approved or denied based on academic (passing all subjects and CRP must be complete), disciplinary (continual compliance with school rules) and financial standing with the school (no school debts owed). Applications can be picked up at Mrs. Loke's desk in the main office. There will be **NO SENIOR PRIVILEGE** on January 23, 2019, which is the first day of the second semester.
