Attention Student Drivers: This is a reminder that all student drivers are required to have a valid 2019/20 parking permit to be able to park on campus during school hours. Seniors may also select Club Early Release. Student Pictures – Picture day is Wednesday, September 4th. All new students and students in grades 9-11 will have their picture taken for their student ID and our Sapphire data base. **SENIORS WILL NOT HAVE THEIR PICTURE TAKEN UNLESS THEY ARE ORDERING A PICTURE PACKAGE.** Pictures will be taken during students’ English classes.
