Student Pictures – Picture day is Wednesday, September 4th. All new students and students in grades 9-11 will have their picture taken for their student ID and our Sapphire data base. **SENIORS WILL NOT HAVE THEIR PICTURE TAKEN UNLESS THEY ARE ORDERING A PICTURE PACKAGE.** Pictures will be taken during students’ English classes. Cyber students may come in during the school day to have their picture taken as their schedule allows. Look for the order form along with the other important papers that are sent home on the first day of school. Students should bring the order form and payment to school on picture day; online ordering is also available – instructions are on the order form.
