

This is a reminder to all students that all vehicles must be registered and must display a school issued parking permit to park on school property during school hours. There will be no warnings issued for students parked on school property without a valid parking permit and all unregistered vehicles will receive a parking violation. **Students with parking permits are reminded that they may only park in their assigned lot.** Please make sure your parking permit is displayed.

The following scholarships are now available for high school seniors in Naviance:

The Scott Nyland Scholarship: Candidates need to have been accepted into a four-year postsecondary institution, have participated in 2 complete seasons on any athletic team or one year as a varsity letter winner, and need a written recommendation from their coach. Return completed applications to the Counseling office by **Monday, April 6th**.

The Robert B. Graupensberger Scholarship: Candidates need to be in the top one third of the class, accepted at a post-secondary institution and demonstrate financial need. Return completed applications to the Counseling office by **Monday, April 6th**.

The Eric Stoler Nursing Scholarship is given to a Senior who has been accepted into a post-secondary program in nursing, has a 2.5 or better cumulative GPA as of the 7th semester, and must have demonstrated a sensitivity to people in need by participation in community service and/or volunteerism. Applications should be submitted with essay to the Counseling Office by **Friday, March 27th**.

Luthercare Nursing Scholarship: A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to one senior at Manheim Township pursuing a career in the nursing field. The application deadline is **Tuesday, March 31**. **See Naviance for submission details.**
