General Information

The Summer School Program developed by the Manheim Township School District offers students an opportunity to expand and/or strengthen their knowledge of concepts and skills. Curricular guides used during the regular school term are followed by summer school teachers to present courses for which students will receive credit.

DATE: All Middle School Credit Recovery Courses will begin on **Monday, June 15, 2020** and end on **Thursday, July 16th**.

PLACE: The Middle School Summer School Program will be provided in a virtual format through Schoology.

Guidelines and Expectations

MTMS Summer School offers online courses through MTSD teacher created courses through the Schoology platform. All school rules apply for students in the virtual setting. Please refer to the 2019-2020 Student Handbook.

Students are expected to follow the suggested pacing for each course. Instructors will regularly record student progress in the virtual platform to keep students and parents/guardians updated. Students and parents/guardians are encouraged to check student progress regularly and contact the instructor with any questions or concerns.

COURSE OFFERINGS

All Middle School Credit Recovery Core Classes (English, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science)

Cost: \$300

Grades: 7, 8

All of these courses can be taken by students who have previously failed these courses. The online course work is delivered through the Schoology platform.

Accommodations and modifications are made on an individual basis for students who need specially designed instruction.

### **Virtual Honors Physical Science (sum.00.20)**

**Credits:** 1.0

**Cost:** \$300

**Grades:** 8, 9, 10

**Course Window:** June 9 - July 23

This course is for accelerated and self-motivated students who excelled in Algebra 1 (85% or higher) and science in 8<sup>th</sup> grade (89% or higher) and would like to take Physical Science before the beginning of the school year. Students who have excelled in Algebra IA and Life Science (85% or higher in both) may take this course at the end of their 9<sup>th</sup> or 10<sup>th</sup> grade year. For those students who are motivated to work hard, this course will cover the essential content of the traditional Honors Physical Science course in order to prepare them to take Honors Biology, Chemistry, and Physics. **This course will be entered as PASS/FAIL for 8<sup>th</sup> graders. All other students will have a grade and percentage issued to their transcript. This schedule is based on current calendar parameters which are subject to change.**

### **Virtual Traditional Physical Education – Sports and Fitness Course 1 (sum.0.21)**

**Credits:** .5 (for credit recovery or advanced credit)

**Cost:** \$300

**Grade:** 8, 9, 10, 11 & 12

**Course Window:** June 9 - July 17

This course is intended for those students wishing to earn one of the three required credits in physical education. Normally this course is completed in school, several hours a day, for a few weeks. During this online adapted version of the course, participants will be expected to perform, and submit, weekly workouts using a school-issued heart rate monitor. Students will also participate in online learning with an emphasis on project-based activities. This online learning will take place on Schoology. Grading will be based on the combination of workout criteria and Schoology projects. Once registration is completed, students will be contacted about receiving the heart rate monitors.
