Attention all 9th-11th grade students: If you are interested in taking the PSAT on October 17th all registration will be done through mail this year. All information can be found in the PSAT folder on your "Class of" Schoology course. If you have any questions email Mrs. Hall in the counseling office.

Students who took CP or Honors Biology during the 2019-20 school year will be taking the Biology Keystone Exam this fall. A proficient score on the exam will satisfy this graduation requirement. Student Picture Day(s): Students in grades 9-11 will have their picture taken for the yearbook/student ID on either September 9th or 10th during their English class. Seniors will NOT have their picture taken unless they are newly enrolled at MTSD this year (senior portraits are used for the yearbook, and students' 11th grade pictures will be used for Sapphire and student IDs).

Picture Day for Face-To-Face students A-L will take place on Wednesday, September 9th; and for **Face-to-Face students M-Z** on Thursday, September 10th.

All Grade 9-11 Remote and MTVA students are required to get their picture taken as well for their school ID. These photos will be taken from 3 PM - 7 PM on September 9th & 10th. Remote and MTVA students must sign-up using the links in the MTHS weekly update email to book their picture appointment time.

Students should bring their order form with them, as well as payment (or pay online) when they have their picture taken. Forms were sent home the first day of school, can be picked up in the main office, or downloaded from the HS webpage with other first day of school papers

This is a reminder to all students that all vehicles must be registered and must display a school issued parking permit to park on school property during school hours. There will be no warnings issued for students parked on school property without a valid parking permit and all unregistered vehicles will receive a parking violation. **Students with parking permits are reminded that they may only park in their assigned lot.** Please make sure your parking permit is displayed.
