**If players qualify to play in the Philadelphia Section Junior Championship on August 16, their 18 hole score for that tournament will count as their day 1 score.

Qualifying for Matches

Exemptions:

- Players who shoot 79 or better in previous match
- Players who finish in the top 10 in previous match

Qualifying - for players who are not exempt, a 9 or 18 hole qualifying (pending on time) will be had to fill remaining spots.

Expected Behavior

1. Respect Staff (Coaches, teachers, administrators, etc..)
2. Respect Teammates and Classmates
3. Respect Yourself - Act in a mature fashion both on and off the course.
4. Respect Community - We are guests of the golf courses where we practice, play and compete.

Any player found not in compliance with these expectations risks possible disciplinary action from the team.

Academics
