Return of iPads (Seniors only)

Exam Conflicts

If you have more than one exam in a block, **you** must make arrangements with your teacher to schedule a make-up exam.

All Students: Planned Absences

If you plan to be absent during exams, **you** must bring in a parent note for the planned absence and receive approval from your principal. Once this is done **you** must contact your teachers to make other arrangements for your exams.

Underclassmen:

If you have a class that is not listed, check with your teacher if you will have an exam and when/where it will be scheduled.

Transportation - IMPORTANT!

There will be NO special bus runs for final exams - only the regular morning and afternoon runs. Students may arrange their own transportation, or remain in the cafeteria to study until 2:30.

2023 Manheim Township High School Final Exams

Important Notes and Information:

1. **You only need to be in school if you have a scheduled exam. You do not need to be here on Make-up Exam days unless you need to make-up an exam. If you have more than one exam during the day, you must remain in the building between exams.**
2. You are responsible for knowing your schedule. If you have any questions, contact your teachers.
3. Seniors must enter the building through the Main Entrance or Cafeteria if coming in for second or third block exams on May 24-26. They must go immediately to the Cafeteria until their exam time. Senior make-up exams will take place on 5/26/23 and 5/30/23, in Convo Hall; Underclass make-up exams will take place on 6/1/23 and 6/2/23, in Convo Hall.
4. Any underclassmen with a senior exam May 24-26, will be excused from their regular classes to take the exam. It is very important that you inform your teachers that you will be missing class so you can get any missed materials or information.
5. **The student dress code is still in effect.**
6. **Cell phones are strictly prohibited during the entirety of all exam sessions.**
7. **Backpacks and belongings are to be placed at the front of each testing room.**
8. Buses will run in the morning and afternoon at their regular times. Students are strongly encouraged to arrange their own transportation home upon completion of their exams. Students remaining in the building to take the bus home or waiting for later exams, must report to the Cafeteria. Students can go to the Library in between exam blocks for a **quiet study hall**. You are not permitted in the halls during exam blocks. **Students may park on campus without a permit during exams.**
9. **You must remain in testing locations until the end of each session, even if you are done with the exam.**
10. **ABSENCE POLICY:** You are required to take exams on the date/time they are scheduled. If you are absent, you are responsible for immediately contacting the teacher to arrange a make-up. To make-up an exam, you must submit a legal excuse as listed in the Student Handbook. Failure to take an exam will result in a 0% for the exam.
11. Don't forget to return all your textbooks and other classroom issued items. Each teacher will provide specific instructions for each class.
12. If *school is canceled* (for some emergency), the exam schedule will automatically be continued on the next day that school is in session. If *school is delayed*, the times for the exams will be pushed back according to the length of the delay.
13. **LOCKER CLEAN OUT:** Seniors must clean their lockers by Friday, May 26, and underclassmen by Wednesday, May 31. Leave the door open with the padlock locked on the hasp. **If the lock is still facing backwards and the student DID NOT use their locker - they do not need to open the locker. There will be a \$6.50 fee for missing locks.** This will be placed on student debt lists; **Seniors will need to pay all debts prior to graduation.**
14. **SENIOR RULES ABOUT RETURNING iPADS:**
 - *Seniors may turn in their iPad to the Library with the school issued case, charging brick and charging cable 5/22, 5/23, 5/24, 5/25 or 5/26. All four items will be inspected and fees will be assessed for damaged or missing items.*
 - ALL iPads will be erased at turn-in; **be sure to back-up your iPad.**
 - **If MTHS does not receive SENIOR iPads by Friday, June 2, 2023, they will be considered lost or stolen and added to student debts.**
15. **UNDERCLASSMEN iPADS:**
 - *Underclassmen will keep their iPads for next school year.*
