PSAT Information: If you are planning on attending college after high school, you will be required to take a college entrance exam like the ACT or SAT. The counseling department recommends that you take the PSAT. This is a practice test for the SAT. The PSAT is offered only ONE time per year. Although sophomores are encouraged to take the PSAT, only juniors will be able to compare their scores with juniors across the country. Your original test booklet will be returned to you with the correct answers so you can do additional practice. You will also receive a personalized statement of specific academic skills that need attention, along with suggested steps to improve those skills. Juniors that score high enough on this test will become National Merit Scholarship Semi-Finalists.

The PSAT will be administered at MTHS on the morning of Saturday, October 20, 2012. Registration will be held in the Guidance Office beginning Monday, September 17 through Wednesday, September 26. The fee is \$23.00. You will need to pay when you register. If you pay with a check, it must be made out to Manheim Township High School. Once registered, you will receive more information about the test.
