On Tuesday, May 14<sup>th</sup> (one week from today) any student who is currently enrolled in English 10 or was not proficient on the Literature Keystone taken during the winter session will be taking the Literature Keystone Exam. On Wednesday, May 15<sup>th</sup> any student who is currently enrolled in Biology or who has chosen to retake the exam will be taking the Biology Keystone Exam. On Tuesday, May 21<sup>st</sup> any student who is currently enrolled in Algebra 1 Part 2 or was not proficient on the Algebra Keystone taken during the winter session will be taking the Algebra Keystone Exam. The test sessions will run from 7:45 a.m. – 9:45 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m. These are mandatory state exams that all students must take before graduating from high school. Please make every attempt to be in school, and on-time during the Keystone Exam days! Each student will be assigned to a testing room. Testing room locations will be posted in various locations throughout the school building. **No electronic devices, including cell phones, cameras, and iPods may be in your possession within the testing room.** Please leave all electronic devices in your locker, in your backpack, or at home during Keystone Exam days. Failure to comply will result in severe disciplinary consequences. Students who do not score Proficient or Advanced will be required to retake the exam during the '13-'14 school year.
