Please make every attempt to be in school, and on-time during the Keystone Exam days! Students who are absent will be required to make-up the exam the next day. Please bring a calculator with you to the exam. **No other electronic devices, including cell phones, cameras, and iPods may be in your possession within the testing room.** If you bring electronic devices into the testing room, you must turn them off and place them in your back pack or it must be placed on the teacher's desk. All back packs will be stored in the front of the testing room. Failure to comply will result in severe disciplinary consequences. Students who do not score Proficient or Advanced will be required to retake the exam during the '13-'14 school year.

Seniors with late arrival or early dismissal are expected to be present for the entire school day during Keystone testing. Those students should report to their scheduled study hall classroom.
