Student Parking during Final Exams:

- Classes that look like a 'double block' in 4A, 4B, 5B, or 6C are just a single class period.
- Blanks in your schedule (except your lunch period) will become study halls when you receive your schedule next fall.
- Make sure you have an English, a science, a social studies and a math class in your schedule.
- Make sure your math classes are in the proper sequence. For most students in CP Algebra, CP Algebra 2, and CP Geometry this means you should have Part 1 in Semester 1 and Part 2 in Semester 2. If your math is out of sequence or you are doubled up in one semester with part 1 and part 2, please make an appointment to have your schedule adjusted.
- Students registered for Fit for Life 1 On-line PE MUST have at least one study hall in their Semester 1 schedule for period 2 or period 3 or in their Semester 2 schedule for period 4A or period 7. Fit for Life 2 On-line PE MUST have at least one study hall during period 6 in their Semester 2 schedule.
