**Lockers:** Students may keep their books until their exams, but lockers must be completely empty before they go home for the summer. Underclassmen lockers must be cleaned out by 6/13. Students need to lock their lock on the hasp, leaving the locker door OPEN so that they will not be charged a \$10 locker clean-out fee on their debts.

**ATTENTION ALL UNDERCLASSMEN for two important Final Exam Announcements:**

**FIRST...**You should all have received your special exam schedules from your 1<sup>st</sup> period teacher by now. During exam days, students do not have to be on campus unless they have an exam. This means that if, for example, you do not have an exam until Block 3, you can sleep in a little later and get a ride to arrive in time for the exam to begin at 11:35 AM. Just don't oversleep and be sure to arrive on time because teachers do have the right to not admit you to an exam if you are late and to require you to take it on the June 13<sup>th</sup> make up day. And, yes, this also means that if you only have one exam, for example, during Block 1, you may leave and go home when it ends at 9:00 AM. **You are strongly encouraged to arrange your own transportation on exam days...Because -**

**SECOND...**There will be **NO SPECIAL BUS SCHEDULE THIS YEAR** during Final Exams. The only bus service on those days will be the normal morning delivery to school and the end of day departure at 2:30 PM. If you must take the bus in the morning, but do not have an exam until Block 2 or 3, you must be in the cafeteria until you go to your exam. It is important for students to have a safe and quiet atmosphere in which to take their exams, so you will not be able to be in the corridors or wandering in the building. Likewise, if you complete your exams, but have no transportation home, you must wait for the 2:30 bus in the cafeteria.

Students who have no transportation and will be waiting in the cafeteria for the end of day bus, **MUST** return the signed Exam End of Day Transportation Form that you will receive from your Primetime teachers. This form is required so that we may plan adequate supervision for the cafeteria and for the number of students who will be eating during the 10:50-11:30 AM lunch period.

**So – To recap:**

You only have to be here during the times when you have exams.

Arranging your own transportation ahead of time is wise and will keep you from having to sit in the cafeteria for long periods of time.

If you can't arrange transportation (or walk or ride your bike) and have to remain on campus to take the 2:30 PM bus you **MUST** turn in the Exam End of Day Transportation Form. If you do not have a form on file you will not be able to take the bus. Also, in order to take the bus, you must remain on campus and in the cafeteria for the entire time. No form – No bus...If you leave campus, you will not be allowed to return to take the bus home.

**Student Parking during Final Exams:**

During Senior Exams, June 4,5,6 & 7 all seniors may park on campus whether you have a parking permit or not. Follow ALL parking rules; do not park in staff lots or yellow lined spaces.

First Block – seniors with parking passes should park in their usual lot; seniors without a parking pass should park in Lot A (Band Lot).

Second & Third Block – seniors may park in available spaces in Lot B (front of school) or any other student lot.

**Enter through front doors only;** all other outside doors will be locked.

During Underclass Final Exams, June 10, 11, 12 & 13 any student with a valid driver's license may park in any student lot whether you have a parking permit or not. Follow all parking rules; do not park in staff lots or yellow lined spaces. After 8:00 am, enter through the front doors only; all other outside doors will be locked.
