**Attention all students who are currently taking Algebra 1 Part 2, Survey of Mathematics, or Algebra 2 Part 1 who were not proficient on the May Keystones.** Tomorrow, January 8<sup>th</sup> and Thursday, January 9<sup>th</sup> you will be taking the Algebra Keystone Exam from 8:35 a.m. – 10:20 a.m. These are mandatory state exams that all students must take before graduating from high school. Please make every attempt to be in school, and on-time during the Keystone Exam days! Each student will be assigned to a testing room. Testing room locations will be posted in various locations throughout the school building. **Students must bring their own calculator. All electronic devices, including cell phones, cameras, and iPods are not permitted within the testing room.** Please leave all electronic devices in your locker or at home during Keystone Exam days. If you are in possession of electronic devices, you must turn them off and place them in your back pack prior to entering the testing room or it must be placed in a secure envelope that your teacher will collect. All back packs will be stored in the front of the testing room. Failure to comply will result in severe disciplinary consequences. Students who do not score Proficient or Advanced will be required to retake the exam in May. **Please remember to bring a calculator!!!** Administration
