This Keystone Exam message is for any student who is currently taking Biology, English 10, or an Algebra Keystone related course. On Tuesday, May 20th any student who is currently enrolled in an English 10 course will be taking the Literature Keystone Exam. On Tuesday, May 27th any student who is currently enrolled in a Biology course will be taking the Biology Keystone Exam. On Wednesday, May 28th any student who is currently enrolled in Algebra 1 Part 2, Survey of Mathematics, Algebra 2 Part 1 that has not scored proficient on the Keystone exam, or Honors Algebra 2 who has not scored proficient will be taking the Algebra Keystone Exam. These are mandatory state exams that all students must take before graduating from high school. Please make every attempt to be in school, and on-time during the Keystone Exam days! Each student will be assigned to a testing room. Testing room locations will be posted in various locations throughout the school building. **No electronic devices, including cell phones, cameras, and iPods may be in your possession within the testing room.** Please leave all electronic devices in your locker or at home during Keystone Exam days. If you are in possession of electronic devices, you must turn them off and place them in your back pack prior to the beginning of testing or it must be placed in a secure envelope that your teacher will collect. All back packs will be stored in the front of the testing room. Failure to comply will result in severe disciplinary consequences (Including ISS and OSS). Students who do not score Proficient or Advanced may be required take remedial courses next school year and will have to retake the exam during the '14-'15 school year. Administration
