

**Students taking the SAT's on Saturday:** Enter through the main lobby doors. Doors will open at 7:30 a.m. and close PROMPTLY at 8:00 a.m. Please bring your admissions ticket, a valid photo ID, #2 pencils, and a calculator. If you do not have your admissions ticket and a valid photo ID you will not be permitted to test! The name on your admissions ticket must exactly match the name on your photo ID. It is advised not to bring a cell phone. If your cell phone makes any noise during testing you will be dismissed and your scores will be canceled.

**2015-2016 Course Selection:** Due to the snow days, the course selection window has been extended until 11:59 PM today, Wednesday, March 11<sup>th</sup>. **Advanced Placement (AP) exam registration** will be held online through Naviance until March 13. Students must sign up for each exam by completing the AP Registration Survey under the ABOUT ME tab on Naviance. The fee for each exam is \$91. Students must bring in payment, along with their printed registration form from Naviance, to the Guidance Office by 3:30 on March 13th. **Seniors are advised to sign up for AP Exams prior to Friday due to the Mock Crash Assembly.** Additional details will be provided on Naviance - please read and follow the instructions carefully. Any exams ordered after that time will be subject to a \$55 late penalty. Exams will be administered May 4-8 and May 11-15.
