

TODAY IS A CLUB DAY.**KEYSTONE EXAM INFORMATION:**

On Monday, January 11 and Tuesday, January 12 the first and second Modules of the **Algebra Keystone exam** will be given to students finishing up math Keystone courses. On Monday, all students will report to their 1st period classrooms where attendance will be taken. At 7:40, you will be dismissed to your second period classes and those taking the keystones will report to their assigned test taking rooms. On Tuesday, those testing will report directly to their testing areas and all others will report to their first period class. Lists of test takers will be made available to all teachers.

On Wednesday, January 13 any student who is enrolled in Biology Remediation will be taking the **Biology Keystone exam** in Convo Hall. Module 1 will be from 7:30-9:25am and Module 2 from 12:30-2:10pm. All other students will follow a regular class schedule for the day.

These are mandatory state exams that students must take and those in the Class of 2017 must score proficient before graduating from high school. Please make every attempt to be in school and on time during the Keystone Exam days.

Students who do not score Proficient or Advanced will be required to retake the exam at another time.

No electronic devices, including cell phones, cameras, and iPods, may be in your possession within the testing room. Please leave all electronic devices in your locker, in your back pack, or at home during Keystone exam days. Failure to comply will result in severe disciplinary consequences.
