SPECIAL SENIOR ASSEMBLY: Jostens will visit our school for a senior assembly during 3rd period on 2/10/16 to present information to students about ordering the required cap, gown and tassel, as well as other optional senior class items (graduation announcements, jewelry, clothing, etc.) which may be purchased through Jostens.
