Seniors, do you need help with the FAFSA? If so, there will be a FAFSA Completion Night on Thursday, February 11th from 5-7 PM in the Writing Center at MTHS. Financial Aid representatives will be available to assist students and families in filling out the FAFSA. There will be two sessions, from 5:00-6:00 and 6:00-7:00. Students must sign up in advance as there is limited seating. Families are strongly encouraged to create their FSA ID as soon as possible in order to electronically sign their FAFSA.

SENIORS: If your college requests a mid-year transcript, then you **MUST** fill out another Transcript Release Form. These forms are available in the Guidance Office or College and Career Center. List the colleges, check the mid-year transcript box(es), and return it to the Guidance Office. **IMPORTANT:** Not all colleges request mid-year transcripts. Please check the college's application instructions.

SPECIAL SENIOR ASSEMBLY: Jostens will visit our school for a senior assembly during 3rd period on 2/10/16 to present information to students about ordering the required cap, gown and tassel, as well as other optional senior class items (graduation announcements, jewelry, clothing, etc.) which may be purchased through Jostens. Seniors will receive a packet of information at the assembly. Jostens packets will be available in the main office for our CTC students and those who are absent that day.
