Senior Privilege for Second Semester: First semester senior privileges will expire on the last day of the current semester (January 24). All seniors who are eligible for senior privilege **MUST SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR SECOND SEMESTER.** Applications for senior privilege (late arrival & early dismissal) are now available in the Main Office at Mrs. Loke's desk. Your application must be approved by administration (grades, attendance, debts, discipline and CRP completion will be checked) and you must verify your approval before your privileges will go into effect. Please don't wait until the last minute to apply, as it may take 24-48 hours for the approval process. There will be no late arrival/early dismissal on the first day of the second semester (1/25/16). Note: you do not need to re-apply for Club early release privilege – this is the only privilege that is in effect for the full school year.
