Your application must be approved by administration (grades, attendance, debts, discipline and CRP completion will be checked) and you must verify your approval before your privileges will go into effect. Please don't wait until the last minute to apply, as it may take 24-48 hours for the approval process. Note: you do not need to re-apply for Club early release privilege – this is the only privilege that is in effect for the full school year.
