



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR TEST TAKERS

Students are encouraged to...

- Get a good night's sleep
- Eat a healthy breakfast
- Pay attention to, read, and follow all directions given
- Ask questions if they do not understand
- Read each question carefully. Be aware of multiple-choice questions that ask for the "best answer". Carefully read open-ended items and prompts before responding.
- Completely fill in the answers you selected and erase any answers you change completely
- Work on their own test
- Attempt each test item and question as best as they can
- Check their work!!! Especially before moving to the next test section or closing their test booklet.
- Report any suspected cheating to the test administrator or principal

Students are not allowed to.....

- Bring notes or reference guides to the test with them
- Bring ANY electronic devices (cell phone, smart phone, laptop, tablet, etc.) Encourage students to look over the Electronic Device Policy Guideline sent home last month
- Share calculators or other test materials
- Mark multiple answers in the answer booklet
- Talk or discuss any questions or test items during or after the PSSA
- Take notes or copy any information to take out of the testing area or to share with others
- Leave a test session until the test is complete or until you are instructed to do so
